Before You Start

Skill Level: Intermediate

Size: One Size

Finished Measurements: approx 8 in x 45in unblocked, larger if blocked vigorously

Yarn: 4 x 276 metres (200 gms) worsted weight; shown in Mille Colori (Colour 163)

Needles: 5 mm straight

Gauge: Each 8st x 16 row entrelac is 1.5 ins x 2.5 ins

Hints and Tips:

The pattern has a two garter stitch edge. You may find it easier to use stitch markers to separate the two edge stitches from the entrelacs to keep track of them.

If you have ever thought of learning how to knit backward, entrelac is the perfect project to try this on. It turns the tedium of turning into a challenge of knitting backwards, and really studying how the purl stitch is formed. Give it a try.

Stitch Details

K: Knit

P: Purl

Sl1: Slip 1 purlwise

M1: Make 1 by knitting into the back of the bar between the last stitch worked and the next stitches

P2tog: Purl 2 together

K2tog: Knit 2 together

SSK: Slip one, Knit 1, Pass the slipped stitch over

Pick up and Knit: pickup stitches by knitting into the side of the rows of the previous section

Pick up and Purl: pickup stitches by purling into the side of the rows of the previous section. Alternately, you may find it easier to have the work facing you to pickup and purl. In this case you will be picking up and knitting stitches onto your left hand needle, working from left to right (opposite direction of what you usually do for pickup and knit). Put your needle through the front of your work, wrap yarn from top to bottom and pull the stitch through.

You also need to remember not to turn after you have picked up your stitches if you are picking them up with your work facing you.

Pattern Details

Lower Triangles:

Row 1: K1, turn

Row 2: P1, turn

Row 3: K2, turn

Row 4: P2, turn

Row 5: K3, turn

Row 6: P3, turn

Row 7: K4, turn

Row 8: P4, turn

Row 9: K5, turn

Row 10: P5, turn

Row 11: K6, turn

Row 12: P6, turn

Row 13: K7, turn

Row 14: P7, turn

Row 15: K8

Right Leaning Triangle Left Side:

Row 1: K2, P1, turn

Row 2: K1, M1, K2, turn

Row 3: K2, P1, P2tog turn

Row 4: K2, M1, K2, turn

Row 5: K2, P2, P2tog turn

Row 6: K3, M1, K2, turn

Row 7: K2, P3, P2tog, turn

Row 8: K4, M1, K2, turn

Row 9: K2, P4, P2tog, turn

Row 10: K5, M1, K2, turn

Row 11: K2, P5, P2tog, turn

Row 12: K6, M1, K2, turn

Row 13: K2, P6, P2tog, turn

Row 14: K7, M1, K2, turn

Row 15: K2, P7, P2tog



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Right Leaning Rectangle:

Pickup and purl 8 stitches into the side of the triangle or rectangle just reached, turn

Row 1: K8, turn

Row 2: P7, P2tog, turn

Rows 3-14: Repeat Rows 1 and 2 six times more

Row 15: K8, turn

Row 16: P7, P2tog

Row 9: P4, turn

Row 10: S11, K2, SSK, turn

Row 11: P3, turn

Row 12: S11, K1, SSK, turn

Row 13: P2, turn

Row 14: S11, SSK, turn

Row 15: P1, turn

Row 16: S11

Right Leaning Triangle Right Side:

Pickup and purl 8 stitches into the side of the triangle or rectangle just reached, turn

Row 1: K8, turn

Row 2: P7, K2tog, K1, turn

Row 3: K9, turn

Row 4: P6, K2tog, K1, turn

Row 5: K8, turn

Row 6: P5, K2tog, K1, turn

Row 7: K7, turn

Row 8: P4, K2tog, K1, turn

Row 9: K6, turn

Row 10: P3, K2tog, K1, turn

Row 11: K5, turn

Row 12: P2, K2tog, K1, turn

Row 13: K4, turn

Row 14: P1, K2tog, K1, turn

Row 15: K3, turn

Row 16: K2tog, K1, turn

Scarf Instructions:

1. **Cast on:** 28 (2 edge stitches, 3 entrelacs of 8 stitches each, 2 edge stitches). (See Hints and Tips)
2. **Beginning Rows 1-5:** Knit across, turn
3. **Lower Triangle Section:** K2, Work 3 Lower Triangles, K2
4. **Right Leaning Section:**
 - i. Work 1 Right Leaning Triangle Left Side,
 - ii. Work 2 Right Leaning Rectangles,
 - iii. Work 1 Right Leaning Triangle Right Side
5. **Left Leaning Section:**
 - i. K2,
 - ii. Work 3 Left Leaning Rectangles,
 - iii. K2
6. **Repeat Right Leaning Section and Left Leaning Section until scarf is about 2 inches short of desired length**
7. **Work one more Right Leaning Section**
8. **Upper Triangle Section:**
 - i. K2,
 - ii. Work 3 Upper Triangles,
 - iii. K2
9. **Ending Row 1:** Knit across. If you are fearful of gaps across the stitches knit each stitch together with the loop below the stitch all across the row, to close gaps
10. **Endind Rows 2-6:** Knit across, turn
11. **Bind off knitwise**

Left Leaning Rectangle:

Pickup and knit 8 stitches into the side of the triangle or rectangle just reached, turn

Row 1: P8, turn

Row 2: K7, SSK, turn

Rows 3-14: Repeat rows 1-2 six times more

Row 15: P8, turn

Row 16: K7, SSK

Upper Triangle:

Pickup and knit 8 stitches into the side of the rectangle just reached, turn

Row 1: P8, turn

Row 2: S11, K6, SSK, turn

Row 3: P7, turn

Row 4: S11, K5, SSK, turn

Row 5: P6, turn

Row 6: S11, K4, SSK, turn

Row 7: P5, turn

Row 8: S11, K3, SSK, turn

Finishing:

Work ends in. Block gently if you want the entrelac "puffs" to show, block severely if you want a flat scarf.
